

TRAVEL TIPS

REMEMBER TO WAIT FOR THE ITINERARIES TO BE CONFIRMED BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH THE PURCHASE OF TICKETS

Travel documents and insurance:

Make sure you have a valid (not expired) ID card or a valid passport. However, UE citizens can enter Italy with their ID cards only. Also, make sure to have your European Health Card

We advise you to take out insurance that covers the duration of the exchange in order to prevent any unforeseen events.

Look for the cheapest means of public transport. Taxis and private vehicles will not be reimbursed.

SAFETY FIRST

REIMBURSMENT

To receive reimbursement, you must provide us with the following documents/tickets:

An invoice for the tickets, which you receive upon purchasing the ticket

- Your flight ticket or electronic ticket with the passenger's name and flight details

- Confirmation of reservation if it is separate from the electronic ticket

- All boarding passes; if they are online, take screenshots to ensure they are saved on your smart device

- A bank document indicating that the payment was made, such as a receipt, bank statement, or confirmation

- For non-online purchases such as train and bus tickets, a receipt showing that the payment was made.

Please ensure that you have all these documents when you come to Italy. If online check-in is not available, the return boarding passes may be sent by regular post after the project.

This information will be used to compose a presentation that will be shown during the exchange and which will try to analyze the reasons that have generated the problem of the lack of youth representation and young people's distrust towards institutions and the possible solutions that can be implemented.
