About the project

IKDS Foundation, together with


partners from 8 countries, wants to organize a training course that will provide youth workers with eco knowledge and facilitating skills

We want to move from a 'week-long' international experience to longer-term support that is more connected to participants' local conditions. Through this project we want to come closer to answering the following questions: How can we, as youth workers, behave in a responsible and sustainable way in our work? How can we motivate and teach the young people we work with to create sustainable habits in their lives? How can we move from consuming goods and products to 'consuming' learning opportunities? How can we make learning about sustainability easy and attractive for young people from disadvantaged groups?

The project "ECO-LOGIC-ALL" was created with the intention of introducing the topic of sustainability into youth work. The topic of climate change is a 'hot' topic in the European Union and around the world. Leading scientists and politicians warn that if action is not taken to slow global warming, we are in grave danger of droughts, floods, extreme heat, species extinction and extreme poverty for millions of people around the world.





The main objectives of the project are the following:




Increasing awareness about sustainable development in working with youth.

Teaching youth workers the basic concepts of learning process design (non-formal education) and applying them in practice.




Equipping individuals working with youth with innovative methods and tools on sustainable development, supporting them in responding to environmental and social issues in innovative ways, and incorporating it into their work.

Creating a space for discussion on the specifics of working with groups with fewer opportunities and presenting innovative ideas that support effective work with these groups.



Providing a space for youth workers to design non-formal learning activities on given topics, conduct them in a safe environment, and receive feedback on their work.
